## LOCAL GOVERNMENT, ENGLAND AND WALES

**The Under-Sheriffs' Bailiwicks Order 1974**

*Made*        -        -        -        11th February 1974

*Coming into Operation*                      1st April 1974

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 219(4) of the Local Government Act 1972(a), hereby makes the following Order:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Under-Sheriffs' Bailiwicks Order 1974 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1974.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2.—(1) The area for which each under-sheriff is to act shall be known as a bailiwick and any reference to a bailiwick in this Order shall be construed accordingly.

(2) Subject to paragraph 3 of this Order, each area for which an under-sheriff acted immediately before 1st April 1974 shall constitute a bailiwick.

3. In the area for which the under-sheriff of Glamorgan acted immediately before 1st April 1974, there shall be two bailiwicks (to be known as the bailiwick of Glamorgan and the bailiwick of Swansea) each of which shall comprise the areas set out in column 2 of the Schedule to this Order opposite the name of that bailiwick in column 1.

## BAILIWICKS OF GLAMORGAN AND SWANSEA

<i>Column 1</i> Bailiwick	<i>Column 2</i> Areas comprised in Bailiwick
Glamorgan	<p>The county of Mid Glamorgan, except the areas formerly in the administrative counties of Brecon and Monmouthshire.</p> <p>The county of South Glamorgan, except the area formerly in the administrative county of Monmouthshire.</p> <p>In the county of West Glamorgan, the districts of Afan and Neath.</p>
Swansea	<p>In the county of West Glamorgan, the districts of Lliw Valley and Swansea.</p>

This Order prescribes the areas for which under-sheriffs are to act on and after the coming into force of the Local Government Act 1972. In general the existing areas are preserved.
