

**1974 No. 637 (L.10)****BANKRUPTCY, ENGLAND****The Bankruptcy Fees (Amendment) Order 1974**

*Made - - - - 26th March 1974*  
*Coming into Operation 1st May 1974*

The Lord Chancellor and the Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 133 of the Bankruptcy Act 1914<sup>(a)</sup> and sections 2 and 3 of the Public Offices Fees Act 1879<sup>(b)</sup>, hereby make, sanction and consent to the following Order:—

**1.**—(1) This Order may be cited as the Bankruptcy Fees (Amendment) Order 1974 and shall come into operation on 1st May 1974.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889<sup>(c)</sup> shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

**2.** The Bankruptcy Fees Order 1970<sup>(d)</sup>, as amended <sup>(e)</sup>, shall have effect subject to the following amendment:—

in Fee No. 41, in part II of Table A in the Schedule to that Order, for the figures “£0.15s.0d.” and “£0.75” there shall be substituted the figures “£0.17s.0d.” and “£0.85” respectively.
