The Probation (Allowances) (Amendment) Rules 1974

Coming into Operation 6th May 1974

2. In paragraph 3(2) of Schedule 1 to the Probation (Allowances) Rules 1971(e) as amended (f) for the words “5·5p”, “6·2p” and “6·9p” there shall be substituted the words “6·4p”, “6·9p” and “7·8p” respectively.
