**The Cessation of Approved Institutions (Abbeyfields School)
Order 1974**

Made - - - 7th May 1974

Coming into Operation 1st June 1974

The Secretary of State for Social Services in exercise of her power under section 46 of the Children and Young Persons Act 1969(a) and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Cessation of Approved Institutions (Abbeyfields School) Order 1974, and shall come into operation on 1st June 1974.

Interpretation

2.—(1) In this order unless the context otherwise requires—

“Planning Area No. 4” means the area so designated in the Schedule to the Children and Young Persons (Planning Areas) Order 1974(b);

“approved institution” has the meaning assigned to it under section 46 of the Children and Young Persons Act 1969.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply to the interpretation of this order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Cessation as an approved institution

3. It having appeared to the Secretary of State that in consequence of the establishment of community homes in Planning Area No. 4, the school, approved by the Secretary of State in pursuance of section 79(1) of the Children and Young Persons Act 1933(d) and known as Abbeyfields School, is no longer required as such, she hereby orders that the said school shall cease to be an approved institution as from 1st June 1974.
