In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 60(2) of the Powers of Criminal Courts Act 1973(a), I hereby make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Powers of Criminal Courts Act 1973 (Commencement No. 1) Order 1974.
2. The provisions of the Powers of Criminal Courts Act 1973, other than section 6(3)(b), (6)(b) and (10), shall come into force on 1st July 1974.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order brings into force on 1st July 1974 the provisions of the Powers of Criminal Courts Act 1973 (which consolidates certain enactments relating to the powers of courts to deal with offenders and defaulters, to the treatment of offenders and to arrangements for persons on bail) with the exception of those provisions in section 6 of the Act which relate to the making of a community service order in proceedings for breach of a requirement of a probation order and which derive from provisions of the Criminal Justice Act 1972 (C.71) which will not be in force on that date.
