## CUSTOMS AND EXCISE

## The Anti-Dumping Duty Order 1975

Made - - - -	13th March 1975
Laid before the House of Commons -	13th March 1975
Coming into Operation	13th March 1975

Whereas by the Anti-Dumping (Provisional Charge to Duty) Order 1974(a) which came into operation on 19th September 1974 goods of the description set out in the Schedule hereto were made subject to a provisional charge in respect of an anti-dumping duty at the rate of 30 per cent:

And, whereas the said Order, as extended (b), remains in force.

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State, in exercise of powers conferred by sections 1, 2, 8 and 9(3) of the Customs Duties (Dumping and Subsidies) Act 1969(c) and now vested in him (d), hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Anti-Dumping Duty Order 1975 and shall come into operation on 13th March 1975.
2. The Interpretation Act 1889(e) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. There shall be charged on the importation into the United Kingdom of any goods of the description set out in the Schedule hereto (being goods classified in the Customs Tariff 1959(f) falling within the heading mentioned in the first column of that Schedule) a duty of customs at the rate set out in the third column; and the said duty shall be chargeable on and after 19th September 1974.
4. Section 2 of the Customs Duties (Dumping and Subsidies) Act 1969 shall apply to the duty imposed by this Order.

## SCHEDULE

Relevant Tariff Heading	Description of Goods	Relevant Rate
ex 44.23 BII	Wooden doors and panels, wholly or partly louvered, originating in Taiwan	30%

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Order.)*

This Order imposes an anti-dumping duty at the rate of 30 per cent. on imports of wooden doors and panels, wholly or partly louvered, of Tariff Heading ex 44.23 BII originating in Taiwan.

The duty is chargeable retrospectively as from 19th September 1974 (when such goods became subject to a provisional charge).

The Order applies to the duty section 2 of the Customs Duties (Dumping and Subsidies) Act 1969, which enables relief to be granted where particular goods have not been dumped or the margin of dumping is less than the amount of duty.
