The Policing of Airports (Gatwick) Order 1975

In exercise of the power conferred on me by subsection (1) of section 1 of the Policing of Airports Act 1974(a), after such consultation as is mentioned in subsection (2) thereof and with such consent as is mentioned in subsection (3)(a) thereof, I hereby make the following Order:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Policing of Airports (Gatwick) Order 1975 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1975.
- 2. Gatwick Airport is hereby designated for the purposes of the Policing of Airports Act 1974.

EXPLANATORY NATE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

The Policing of Airports Act 1974 makes provision for enabling the policing of any airport designated thereunder to be undertaken by the police force for the area in which it is wholly or mainly situated.

This Order designates Gatwick Airport (which is within Sussex and so falls to be policed by the police force for that county).
