## **ROAD TRAFFIC**

The Heavy Goods Vehicles (Drivers' Licences) (Amendment)
(No. 2) Regulations 1976

Made - - 6th July 1976

Laid before Parliament 9th July 1976

Coming into Operation 1st August 1976

The Secretary of State for the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 119(1) of the Road Traffic Act 1972(a), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with representative organisations in accordance with section 199(2) of that Act, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

- 1. These Regulations shall come into operation on 1st August 1976 and may be cited as the Heavy Goods Vehicles (Drivers' Licences) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 1976.
- 2.—(1) The Heavy Goods Vehicles (Drivers' Licences) Regulations 1975(b), as amended (c), shall be further amended so as to have effect as if for Regulation 22 (Fees for tests) there were substituted the following Regulation:—
- "Fees for tests
  - 22. The fee payable in respect of a test to be conducted by an examiner appointed under Regulation 17(1)(a) shall be—
    - (a) £8 where the application for an appointment for the test was received by the person specified in Regulation 15(1) before the 1 August 1976;
    - (b) £24, in any other case."
