SEA FISHERIES

The Herring Industry Board (Exchequer Loans) Order 1976

Made - - - 12th May 1976

Laid before the House of Commons 25th May 1976

Coming into Operation 16th July 1976

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Secretaries of State respectively concerned with the sea fishing industry in Scotland and Northern Ireland in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 35(3) of the Sea Fish Industry Act 1970(a) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, with the approval of the Treasury, hereby make the following Order:—

1.—(1) This Order, which may be cited as the Herring Industry Board (Exchequer Loans) Order 1976, shall come into operation on the day following the day on which it is approved by the Commons House of Parliament.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. The limit of £4 million imposed by section 35(1) of the Sea Fish Industry Act 1970 as amended by section 1(2) of the Sea Fish Industry Act 1973(c) and extended (d) of the amount outstanding at any time of the sums advanced under the aforementioned section 35(1) and section 7(2) of the White Fish and Herring Industries Act 1953(e) (Exchequer loans to the Herring Industry Board) shall be raised by the sum of £500,000.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order is made under section 35 of the Sea Fish Industry Act 1970. It raises by £500,000 the limit of £4 million imposed in relation to the amount which may be outstanding at any time of the sums advanced by the Exchequer to the Herring Industry Board for any purpose approved by the Ministers and the Treasury.

This Order was approved by a resolution of the House of Commons on 15th July 1976 and came into operation on 16th July 1976.
