The Countervailing Duty Order 1976

Made - - - - - 28th July 1976

*Laid before the
House of Commons* 28th July 1976

Coming into Operation 28th July 1976

Whereas by the Countervailing (Provisional Charge to Duty) Order 1976(a) which came into operation on 29th April 1976 goods of the description set out in the Schedule hereto were made subject to a provisional charge in respect of a countervailing duty at the rate of 16 per cent.

And whereas the said Order remains in force.

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State, in exercise of powers conferred by sections 1, 7 and 8 of the Customs Duties (Dumping and Subsidies) Act 1969(b) and now vested in him(c), hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Countervailing Duty Order 1976 and shall come into operation on 28th July 1976.

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(d) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. There shall be charged on the importation into the United Kingdom of any goods of the description set out in the Schedule hereto (being goods classified in the Customs Tariff 1959(e) falling within the heading mentioned in the first column of that Schedule) a duty of customs at the rate set out in the third column; and the said duty shall be chargeable on and after 29th April 1976.

ex 64.02 A.I.b } A.II.b }	Men's moccasins and boots with leather uppers, and shoes with leather uppers having an overall heel height measured from the back seam exceeding 12.5 mm or with soles exceeding 5 mm in thickness measured from the front of the shoes, originating in the Federative Republic of Brazil.	8%

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order imposes a countervailing duty at the rate of 8 per cent. on imports of certain men's leather footwear originating in Brazil.

The duty is chargeable retrospectively as from 29th April 1976 (when such goods became subject to a provisional charge at the rate of 16%).
