The Further Education (Amendment) Regulations 1976

<i>Made</i> - - - -	28th July 1976
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	5th August 1976
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	27th August 1976

The Secretary of State for Education and Science, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 100(1)(b) and (3) of the Education Act 1944(a) and vested in him(b), hereby makes the following regulations:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Further Education (Amendment) Regulations 1976 and shall come into operation on 27th August 1976.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the interpretation of these regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Grants for trade union studies

2.—(1) After regulation 32 of the Further Education Regulations 1975(d) (“the principal regulations”) there shall be inserted as a new regulation—

“32A.—(1) The Secretary of State may pay grants to—

(a) the Trades Union Congress;

(b) any independent trade union—

in respect of expenditure incurred by them in the provision of courses in trade union studies and courses for the training of teachers in such studies.

(2) In sub-paragraph (b) above the expression “independent trade union” has the meaning assigned to it by section 30(1) of the Trade Union and Labour Relations Act 1974(e).”

(2) The reference in regulation 33(2) of the principal regulations to regulations 29 to 33 of those regulations shall be construed as including a reference to regulation 32A.

Application of regulations to voluntary establishments

3.—(1) Regulation 21 of the principal regulations shall have the effect with the substitution for the references to regulations 6 and 8 to 16 of references to regulations 6, 6A and 8 to 16.

(2) Regulation 2(2) of the Further Education (Transitional Exemption Orders) Regulations 1975(a) (which amended regulation 21 of the principal regulations) is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Further Education Regulations 1975.

Regulation 2 enables the Secretary of State for Education and Science to pay grants to the TUC and independent trade unions (within the meaning of the Trade Unions and Labour Relations Act 1974) in respect of courses in trade union studies.

Regulation 3 corrects a drafting error in the Further Education (Transitional Exemption Orders) Regulations 1975.
