**The Anti-Dumping and Countervailing Duties Order 1973
(Amendment) (No. 2) Order 1976***Made* - - - - - 28th July 1976*Laid before the House of Commons* 4th August 1976*Coming into Operation* - - - 25th August 1976

The Secretary of State, in exercise of powers conferred by sections 1, 2 and 15(4) of the Customs Duties (Dumping and Subsidies) Act 1969(a) and now vested in him(b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Anti-Dumping and Countervailing Duties Order 1973 (Amendment) (No. 2) Order 1976 and shall come into operation on 25th August 1976.

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. The Anti-Dumping and Countervailing Duties Order 1973(d), as amended (e), shall be further amended by deleting from Schedule 1 the following entry:—
