REGISTRATION OF FILMS

The Films (Registration) (Amendment) Regulations 1976

Made - - - -

3rd August 1976

Coming into Operation

1st September 1976

The Secretary of State in exercise of powers conferred by section 44 of the Films Act 1960(a), as amended by section 20 of the Films Act 1970(b), and as further amended by section 8 of the European Communities Act 1972(c), and now vested in him(d), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, and with the consent of the Treasury, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Films (Registration) (Amendment) Regulations 1976 and shall come into operation on 1st September 1976.

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(e) shall apply to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament and as if these Regulations and the Regulations hereby revoked were Acts of Parliament.

3. The Films (Registration) Regulations 1970(f), as amended(g), shall have effect as if:—

- (1) in Regulation 5(1) for “£500” there were substituted “£525” and for “£20” there were substituted “£25”;
- (2) in Regulation 5(2) for “£9.50” there were substituted “£12”;
- (3) in Regulation 13 for “£0.30” there were substituted “£0.35”;
- (4) in Regulation 14 for “£1.20” there were substituted “£1.50”.

4. The Films (Registration) (Amendment) Regulations 1975(h) are hereby revoked.

These Regulations further amend the Films (Registration) Regulations 1970 by increasing the fees payable in respect of applications for the registration of all films, applications to amend the register (including those for the registration of a foreign film as a Community film), inspections of the register and applications for certified copies of entries in the register.
