POLICE

The Police (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 1976

Made - - - 5th August 1976

Laid before Parliament 13th August 1976

Coming into Operation 6th September 1976

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 33 of the Police Act 1964(a), and after consulting the Police Council for the United Kingdom in accordance with section 4(4) of the Police Act 1969(b), I hereby make the following Regulations:—

PART I

CITATION, OPERATION, ETC.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Police (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 1976.

2. These Regulations shall come into operation on 6th September 1976 and shall have effect—

- (a) for the purposes of Part II thereof, as from 1st July 1975;
- (b) for the purposes of Part III thereof, as from 1st September 1975;
- (c) for the purposes of Part IV thereof, as from 1st April 1976.

3. In these Regulations any reference to the principal Regulations is a reference to the Police Regulations 1971(c), as amended(d).

PART II

PROVISIONS HAVING EFFECT FROM 1ST JULY 1975

4. In respect of any period beginning on or after 1st July 1975 and ending before 1st September 1975 Regulation 6 of the Police (Amendment) (No. 3) Regulations 1975(e) (increase of pay for certain members of the City of London and metropolitan police forces) shall have effect as if the reference in paragraph (2) thereof to an increase in annual pay of £201 were a reference to such an increase of £245.

5. In paragraph 3(2) of Schedule 4 to the principal Regulations (university scholars) for the annual rate “£275” there shall be substituted the annual rate “£319”.

PART III

PROVISION HAVING EFFECT FROM 1ST SEPTEMBER 1975

6. For paragraph 4(2) of Part II of Schedule 5 to the principal Regulations (supplementary pay for certain members of the City of London and metropolitan police forces) there shall be substituted the following provision:—

“(2) The annual pay of such a member determined in accordance with Part I of this Schedule shall, without prejudice to any increase under the preceding provisions of this Part, be increased by £245”.

PART IV

PROVISION HAVING EFFECT FROM 1ST APRIL 1976

7. In Regulation 47(6) of the principal Regulations (removal allowance) for the sum “£250” there shall be substituted the sum “£370”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Police Regulations 1971 and have effect from the dates mentioned below (Regulation 2); retrospective effect is authorised by section 33(4) of the Police Act 1964.

The annual rate of the supplementary pay payable to certain members of the City of London and metropolitan police forces is increased by £44 with effect from 1st July 1975 (as respects the period 1st July to 1st September 1975, by Regulation 4 and, subsequently, by Regulation 6). Analogous provision is made in the case of a university scholar required to reside in the London area (Regulation 5).

The maximum amount of an allowance in respect of incidental removal expenditure is increased by £120 with effect from 1st April 1976 (Regulation 7).
