BOATS AND METHODS OF FISHING

The Herring (North Irish Sea) Licensing Order 1976

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Secretaries of State respectively concerned with the sea fishing industry in Scotland and Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by sections 4 and 15 of the Sea Fish (Conservation) Act 1967^(a) as the latter section is amended by section 22(1) of, and paragraph 38 of Schedule 1 to, the Sea Fisheries Act 1968^(b) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, being satisfied that substantially equivalent measures are being taken by governments of other countries concerned, hereby make the following order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as The Herring (North Irish Sea) Licensing Order 1976 and shall come into operation on 10th September 1976.

Interpretation

2.—(1) In this order “the Act” means the Sea Fish (Conservation) Act 1967.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889^(c) shall apply to the interpretation of this order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament and as if this order and the order hereby revoked were Acts of Parliament.

Revocation of previous order

3. The Herring (North East Irish Sea) Licensing Order 1975^(d) is hereby revoked.

Appointed day

4. The appointed day for the purposes of section 4 of the Act (which provides for the licensing of British fishing boats in relation to fishing by way of trade or business in specified areas) in conjunction with this order, is 10th September 1976.

Area and fish

5. This order applies to fishing in waters specified in the Schedule to this order for herring (*Clupea harengus*).

Enforcement

6. For the purpose of the enforcement of section 4 of the Act in conjunction with this order, there are hereby conferred on every British sea-fishery officer the powers of a British sea-fishery officer under section 8(2) to (4) of the Sea Fisheries Act 1968.

SCHEDULE

Those waters of the Irish Sea between latitudes 53° 00' North and 55° 00' North which lie outside the fishery limits of the British Islands adjacent to Northern Ireland and the Isle of Man respectively and outside the fishery limits of the Republic of Ireland.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

Section 4 of the Sea Fish (Conservation) Act 1967 provides that from a day appointed by an order, no British fishing boat registered in the United Kingdom shall be used by way of trade or business for fishing in any area specified in the order except under the authority of a licence granted by one of the fisheries Ministers.

This Order appoints 10th September 1976 as the date from which no such fishing boat shall so fish for herring in the area described in the Schedule to the order except under the authority of such a licence.

The Order supersedes the Herring (North East Irish Sea) Licensing Order 1975. The only change is that this order applies to a larger area.
