**The Supreme Court (Non-Contentious Probate) Fees
(Amendment) Order 1976**

Made - - - 26th July 1976

Coming into Operation 1st October 1976

The Lord Chancellor, the Judges of the Supreme Court and the Treasury, in exercise of the powers and authorities vested in them respectively by section 213 of the Supreme Court of Judicature (Consolidation) Act 1925 (a) and sections 2 and 3 of the Public Offices Fees Act 1879 (b), do hereby, according as the provisions of the said enactments respectively authorise and require them, make, advise, consent to and concur in the following Order:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Supreme Court (Non-Contentious Probate) Fees (Amendment) Order 1976 and shall come into operation on 1st October 1976.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889 (c) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. The Schedule to the Supreme Court (Non-Contentious Probate) Fees Order 1975 (d) shall be amended as follows:—

(1) For Fee No. 5 there shall be substituted the following fee:—

“5. For the entry of a caveat or the extension of a caveat £2.00”.

(2) Fee No. 17 (Charitable bequests) shall be omitted.

3. Nothing in this Order shall affect any fee due or payable before the Order comes into operation.
