LAND DRAINAGE

The North West Water Authority (Abolition of the Hesketh Estate (Flood Defences) Commissioners Area) Order 1976

Made - - - - 21st June 1976

Coming into Operation 13th August 1976

Whereas the North West Water Authority prepared and submitted to the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food (hereinafter called "the Minister") for confirmation a Scheme (hereinafter called "the Scheme") under section 4(1)(b), of the Land Drainage Act 1930(a), as amended and applied by the Water Act 1973(b), in relation to the Hesketh Estate (Flood Defences) Commissioners Area:

And whereas the Minister has decided to confirm the Scheme, a copy of which is annexed hereto:

Now, therefore, the Minister, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 4(3) and 14 of the Land Drainage Act 1930, as applied by the Water Act 1973, and of every other power enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1. This Order, which may be cited as the North West Water Authority (Abolition of the Hesketh Estate (Flood Defences) Commissioners Area) Order 1976, shall, unless subject to special parliamentary procedure, come into operation on the date of its confirmation by the Minister.

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. The Scheme is hereby confirmed.

4. The expenses of the Minister in connection with the making and confirmation of this Order shall be borne by the North West Water Authority and shall be part of the administrative expenses of that Authority.

NORTH WEST WATER AUTHORITY

ABOLITION OF THE HESKETH ESTATE (FLOOD DEFENCES) COMMISSIONERS
AREA

The North West Water Authority (hereinafter referred to as "the Authority") have prepared the following Scheme under section 4(1)(b) of the Land Drainage Act 1930, as amended and applied by the Water Act 1973, and submit it to the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food (hereinafter referred to as "the Minister") for confirmation under section 4(3) of the said Act of 1930.

SCHEME

On a day to be appointed by the Minister (which day is hereinafter referred to as "the appointed day") the following provisions shall have effect:—

1. The Hesketh Estate (Flood Defences) Commissioners Area (constituted by the Hesketh Estate (Flood Defences) Act 1914(a) and subsequently amended and enlarged by the River Douglas Catchment Board (Alteration of Boundaries of the Hesketh Estate (Flood Defences) Commissioners Area) Order 1943(b)) and the Commissioners thereof shall be abolished.

2. Any monies held by the Authority immediately before the appointed day being the balance of drainage rates levied by them in the exercise of their functions as the drainage authority (in consequence of the River Douglas Catchment Board (Transfer of Powers of the Hesketh Estate (Flood Defences) Commissioners) Order 1946) shall be applied by the Authority as if the same were the proceeds of a general drainage charge levied by them under the provisions of sections 1 and 1A of the Land Drainage Act 1961(c) as substituted by section 19(4) of, and paragraph 12(1) of Schedule 5 to, the Water Act 1973.

3. Any debts due from the operations of the Authority acting as the drainage authority for the Hesketh Estate (Flood Defences) Commissioners Area immediately before the coming into operation of this Scheme shall be discharged by the Authority.
