**1976 No. 1401****CRIMINAL PROCEDURE, ENGLAND AND WALES****The Fixed Penalty (Procedure) (Amendment) (No. 2)  
Regulations 1976**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 80(11) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967(a), I hereby make the following Regulations:—

**1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Fixed Penalty (Procedure) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 1976 and shall come into operation on 1st October 1976.

**2.** In Schedule 2 to the Fixed Penalty (Procedure) (No. 2) Regulations 1974(b), as amended (c), there shall be inserted in the appropriate places the entries contained in the Schedule to these Regulations.

## Regulation 2

In the non-metropolitan county of Cambridge-shire the petty sessional divisions of Arrington and Melbourn, Bottisham, Cambridge, Caxton, Ely, Linton and Newmarket.	The clerk to the justices for the Cambridge (City) petty sessional division.
In the non-metropolitan county of East Sussex the petty sessional divisions of Crowborough and Hailsham.	The clerk to the justices for the Eastbourne petty sessional division.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)*

These Regulations amend the Fixed Penalty (Procedure) (No. 2) Regulations 1974 as amended so as to provide that the payment of a fixed penalty for an offence committed in certain petty sessional divisions of the non-metropolitan counties of Cambridgeshire and East Sussex shall be paid to the clerk to the justices for the petty sessional divisions of Cambridge (City) and Eastbourne respectively.
