## The Police (Scotland) Amendment (No. 3) Regulations 1976

*Made* - - - - - 31st August 1976

*Laid before Parliament* 13th September 1976

*Coming into Operation* 4th October 1976

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 26 of the Police (Scotland) Act 1967(a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, and after consulting the Police Council for the United Kingdom in accordance with section 4(4) of the Police Act 1969(b), I hereby make the following regulations:—

## PART I

*Citation, Commencement and Interpretation*

1. These regulations may be cited as the Police (Scotland) Amendment (No. 3) Regulations 1976.
2. These regulations shall come into operation on 4th October 1976 and shall have effect as from 1st April 1976.
3. In these regulations any reference to the principal regulations is a reference to the Police (Scotland) Regulations 1976(c).
4. The Interpretation Act 1889(d) shall apply for the interpretation of these regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

## PART II

*Amendment of principal regulations*

5. In Regulation 47(6) of the principal Regulations (removal allowance) for the sum "£250" there shall be substituted the sum "£370".

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)*

Part II of these Regulations (Regulation 5) relates to incidental removal expenditure. Regulation 5 increases the maximum removal allowance by £120 with effect from 1st April 1976; retrospective effect is authorised by Section 26(3) of the Police (Scotland) Act 1967.
