In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 8(4) of and paragraph 3(1) and 3(3)(b) of Schedule 3 to the Agriculture (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1972(a), I hereby make the following order:—

Citation, commencement and extent

1. This order may be cited as the Improvement of Live Stock (Licensing of Bulls) Act 1931 Suspension of Operation (Scotland) Order 1976, shall come into operation on 1st October 1976, and shall apply only to Scotland.

Interpretation

2.—(1) In this order—

“the Act of 1931” means the Improvement of Live Stock (Licensing of Bulls) Act 1931(b); and

“the Act of 1972” means the Agriculture (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1972.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Suspension of the operation of the Act of 1931

3. The operation of the Act of 1931 (which provides for the improvement of live stock by regulating the keeping of bulls) is suspended from 1st October

1976 until such later date as may be specified in a further order under paragraph 3 of Schedule 3 to the Act of 1972.
