CUSTOMS AND EXCISE

The Import Duties (General) (No. 7) Order 1976*Made* - - - - - 11th October 1976*Laid before the House of Commons* 11th October 1976*Coming into Operation* - - - 1st November 1976

The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury, by virtue of the powers conferred on them by sections 1, 3(6) and 13 of the Import Duties Act 1958(a), as amended by section 5(5) of, and paragraph 1 of Schedule 4 to, the European Communities Act 1972(b), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, on the recommendation of the Secretary of State(c), hereby make the following Order:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Import Duties (General) (No. 7) Order 1976 and shall come into operation on 1st November 1976.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(d) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. Part IV of Schedule 3 to the Import Duties (General) (No. 5) Order 1975(e) shall be amended as specified in the Schedule hereto.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order, which comes into operation on 1st November 1976, amends Part IV of Schedule 3 to the Import Duties (General) (No. 5) Order 1975 by providing for exemptions from or reductions in rates of import duty in the case of certain goods of Portugal.

The Order implements obligations of the United Kingdom under the Interim Agreement implementing the Additional Protocol to the Agreement between the European Economic Community and Portugal.
