(Amendment) Order 1976**

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Whereas by section 20 of the Greenwich Hospital Act 1865(a) it was enacted, *inter alia*, that the authority to establish from time to time regulations for the admission of children in Greenwich Hospital School shall be vested exclusively in the Admiralty but any such regulations shall not have effect unless and until they are approved by Her Majesty in Council:

And whereas by His late Majesty's Order in Council dated 22nd December 1948(b) sanction was given to Regulations for the admission of boys to Greenwich Hospital School (hereinafter referred to as "the Regulations"):

And whereas by section 1(2) of the Defence (Transfer of Functions) Act 1964(c) the authority vested in the Admiralty was transferred to the Secretary of State for Defence:

And whereas the Secretary of State for Defence has recommended to Her Majesty that the Regulations be amended by adding the words "List I (Merchant Navy)" after the word "Reserve" in the fifth line of Regulation I of the Regulations:

Her Majesty is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to approve the amendment to the Regulations recommended by the Secretary of State for Defence.

And the Secretary of State for Defence is to give the necessary directions herein accordingly.

This Order may be cited as the Greenwich Hospital School (Regulations) (Amendment) Order 1976, and shall come into operation on the 5th day of November 1976.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

By Regulation I of the Regulations admission to Greenwich Hospital School is restricted to the sons of British subjects who are the sons of *inter alios* officers and men of the Royal Naval Reserve. This Order amends this Regulation by restricting this category to the sons of officers and men of the Royal Naval Reserve List I (Merchant Navy).
