**The Patents Etc. (Ghana, Libya and Mauritius) (Convention)
Order 1976***Made - - - - 27th October 1976**Coming into Operation 28th October 1976*

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 27th day of October 1976

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred upon Her by section 68 of the Patents Act 1949(a), section 13 of the Registered Designs Act 1949(b) and section 91A of the Patents and Designs Act 1907(c), as amended(d), is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

1. This Order may be cited as the Patents Etc. (Ghana, Libya and Mauritius) (Convention) Order 1976, and shall come into operation on 28th October 1976.

2. Ghana, Libya and Mauritius are Convention countries for all the purposes of the said Acts.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

The Governments of Ghana, Libya and Mauritius have given notice of their respective accessions to the International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property (as revised in Stockholm in 1967).

This Order discharges the obligations of the United Kingdom under the Convention by declaring Ghana, Libya and Mauritius to be Convention countries for all the purposes of the Acts relating to patents, designs and trade marks.
