WATER, ENGLAND AND WALES

The Sutton District Water Order 1976

Made - - - - 22nd October 1976

Coming into Operation 2nd November 1976

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of powers conferred by sections 32 and 50 of the Water Act 1945(a) and now vested in him(b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Sutton District Water Order 1976 and shall come into operation on 2nd November 1976. Citation and commencement.

(2) The Sutton District Water Acts and Orders 1871 to 1975 and this order may be cited together as the Sutton District Water Acts and Orders 1871 to 1976.

2.—(1) In this order—

“the undertaking” means the undertaking of the Sutton District Water Company as for the time being authorised by any enactment;

Interpretation.

and unless the context otherwise requires, any reference in this order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by, or having effect by virtue of, any subsequent enactment, including this order.

3. Section 55 (making and dates for payment of water rates) of the Third Schedule to the Water Act 1945 as applied to the undertaking by section 3 of the Sutton District Water Order 1963(c) shall have effect as if there were inserted at the end of subsection (1) thereof the following proviso:— Power to make quarterly rate.

“Provided that notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this subsection the undertakers may make a water rate by fixing a rate poundage in respect of the period of three months commencing on 1st January 1977.”.

4. For the purposes of this order, section 94 of the Third Schedule to the Water Act 1945 (which requires undertakers to keep a copy of the special Act at their principal office and to deposit copies with certain officers) shall apply to the undertaking and is hereby incorporated with this order.
