1976 No. 184**PUBLIC OFFICE****Court of Session (Scotland) (Fees) Order 1976***Made - - - - 10th February 1976**Coming into Operation 1st April 1976*

The Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 2 of the Public Offices Fees Act 1879^(a) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Court of Session (Scotland) (Fees) Order 1976 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1976.
2. The Interpretation Act 1889^(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. All fees payable to the Court of Session Scotland shall be collected in money.
4. The Treasury Minute dated 25th March 1873 is hereby revoked.
