LEGAL AID AND ADVICE, SCOTLAND**The Legal Advice and Assistance (Scotland)
(Financial Conditions) (No. 2) Regulations 1976***Made - - - - - 13th October 1976**Laid before Parliament 18th October 1976**Coming into Operation 15th November 1976*

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 15 of the Legal Aid (Scotland) Act 1967^(a) as extended by section 6 of the Legal Advice and Assistance Act 1972^(b), and sections 1 and 11 of the Legal Advice and Assistance Act 1972, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following regulations:—

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Legal Advice and Assistance (Scotland) (Financial Conditions) (No. 2) Regulations 1976 and shall come into operation on 15th November 1976.

(2) In these regulations, unless the context otherwise requires, “the Act” means the Legal Advice and Assistance Act 1972 as amended^(c) and other expressions have the same meaning as in the Act.

(3) The Interpretation Act 1889^(d) shall apply for the interpretation of these regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. For the purpose of section 1 of the Act and subject to the provisions thereof, advice and assistance shall be available for any person if his disposable income does not exceed £35 a week and his disposable capital does not exceed £300.

These Regulations increase the disposable income and capital limit for the availability of legal advice and assistance from £30 a week to £35 a week and from £250 to £300 respectively.
