BETTING, GAMING AND LOTTERIES

**The Gaming Clubs (Hours and Charges) (Amendment)
Regulations 1976***Made - - - - - 9th November 1976**Laid before Parliament 22nd November 1976**Coming into Operation 20th December 1976*

In pursuance of sections 14(2) and 51 of the Gaming Act 1968(a), and after consultation with the Gaming Board for Great Britain, I hereby make the following Regulations:—

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Gaming Clubs (Hours and Charges) (Amendment) Regulations 1976 and shall come into operation on 20th December 1976.

(2) These Regulations do not extend to Scotland.

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(b) applies for the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament, and as if these Regulations and the Regulations revoked by these Regulations were Acts of Parliament.

3. Regulation 5(1) of the Gaming Clubs (Hours and Charges) Regulations 1970(c), as amended(d), shall be amended by substituting for the words “75p”, in both places where they occur, the words “£1”.

4. The Gaming Clubs (Hours and Charges) (Amendment) Regulations 1975(e) are hereby revoked.
