CUSTOMS AND EXCISE

The Anti-Dumping Duty (No. 3) Order 1976

Made - - - - 15th November 1976
*Laid before the House
of Commons* - - 15th November 1976
Coming into Operation 15th November 1976

Whereas by the Anti-Dumping (Provisional Charge to Duty) (No. 2) Order 1976(a) which came into operation on 16th September 1976 goods of the description set out in the Schedule hereto were made subject to a provisional charge in respect of an anti-dumping duty at the rate of £0.90 per clock.

And whereas the said Order remains in force:—

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State, in exercise of powers conferred by sections 1 and 8 of the Customs Duties (Dumping and Subsidies) Act 1969(b) and now vested in him(c), hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Anti-Dumping Duty (No. 3) Order 1976 and shall come into operation on 15th November 1976.
2. The Interpretation Act 1889(d) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. There shall be charged on the importation into the United Kingdom of any goods of the description set out in the Schedule hereto (being goods classified in the Customs Tariff 1959(e) falling within the heading mentioned in the first column of that Schedule) a duty of customs at the rate set out in the third column; and the said duty shall be chargeable on and after 16th September 1976.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order imposes an anti-dumping duty at the rate of £0.90 per clock on imports of certain alarm clocks originating in the People's Republic of China.

The duty is chargeable retrospectively as from 16th September 1976 (when such goods became subject to a provisional charge).
