CUSTOMS AND EXCISE

The Import Duties (General) (No. 9) Order 1976*Made* - - - - 29th November 1976*Laid before the
House of Commons* - 29th November 1976*Coming into Operation* 16th December 1976

The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury, by virtue of the powers conferred on them by sections 1, 2, 3(6) and 13 of the Import Duties Act 1958(a), as amended by section 5(5) of, and paragraph 1 of Schedule 4 to, the European Communities Act 1972(b), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, on the recommendation of the Secretary of State (c), hereby make the following Order:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Import Duties (General) (No. 9) Order 1976 and shall come into operation on 16th December 1976.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(d) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

(3) This Order does not increase duties of customs otherwise than in pursuance of a Community obligation.

2. The Import Duties (General) (No. 5) Order 1975(e), as amended (f), shall be further amended as specified in the Schedule hereto.

3. Paragraphs 1 and 3 of Schedule 1 to the Import Duties (General) (No. 3) Order 1976(g) are hereby revoked, and paragraph 4 shall be construed as if the reference therein to the subheadings of 22.05 were a reference to subheading 22.05 C.

SCHEDULE

AMENDMENTS TO THE IMPORT DUTIES (GENERAL) (No. 5) ORDER 1975

1. In Article 11(5) for the words added by paragraph 1 of Schedule 1 to the Import Duties (General) (No. 3) Order 1976 there shall be substituted—

(a) after “heading 04.04” the words “and except for the purpose of calculating the rate of import duty charged in the case of goods falling within subheading 22.05 C.” and

(b) after “Schedule 1” the words “and in the footnotes to subheading 22.05 C. in Schedules 1 and 6”.

2. On pages 196 to 200 in Schedule 1 in columns 3, 4 and 5 of subheading 22.05 C. there shall be inserted an asterisk immediately after “UA” wherever it occurs.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order, which comes into operation on 16th December 1976, further amends the Import Duties (General) (No. 5) Order 1975 which sets out the United Kingdom Customs Tariff and the protective import duties chargeable in accordance with it.

The amendments are made to provide for the current agricultural representative rate to be applied when converting units of account into sterling in calculating rates of import duty on all wines of subheading 22.05 C. in Schedule 1 to that Order.
