Made - - - - - 6th December 1976
Coming into Operation 1st January 1977

The Registrar General in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 3A (as inserted by section 92 of the Children Act 1975(a)) and section 39 of the Births and Deaths Registration Act 1953(b) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, with the approval of the Secretary of State for Social Services, hereby makes the following regulations:—

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Registration of Births (Abandoned Children) Regulations 1976 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1977.

Interpretation

2. The rules for the construction of Acts of Parliament contained in the Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the purposes of the interpretation of these regulations as they apply for the purposes of the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Particulars to be registered

3. The particulars required to be registered pursuant to section 3A of the Births and Deaths Registration Act 1953 (which requires the particulars to be registered in respect of abandoned children to be prescribed) shall be the particulars required in spaces 1 to 6 in the schedule to these regulations.
