**The Goods Vehicles (Authorisation of International Journeys)
(Fees) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 1976**

The Secretary of State for Transport, with the consent of the Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 56(1) and (2) of the Finance Act 1973(a), and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Goods Vehicles (Authorisation of International Journeys) (Fees) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 1976 and shall come into operation on 24th December 1976.

2. Regulation 2(1) of the Goods Vehicles (Authorisation of International Journeys) (Fees) Regulations 1976(b) shall have effect as if for the definition of “community authorisation” therein prescribed, there were substituted the following definition, that is to say:—

“community authorisation” means an authorisation granted pursuant to the Council Regulation on the Community quota for the carriage of goods by road between Member States, adopted by the Council of the European Communities on 16 December 1976(c);

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations substitute in the Goods Vehicles (Authorisation of International Journeys) (Fees) Regulations 1976 (S.I. 1976/2062) a new definition of "community authorisation". This amendment falls to be made as a result of the adoption on the 16th December 1976 by the Council of the European Communities of the E.E.C. Regulation on the Community quota for the carriage of goods by road between Member States which replaces a temporary E.E.C. Regulation due to expire on 31st December 1976.
