**The Diseases of Animals (Fees for the Testing of
Disinfectants) Order 1976**

Made - - - - 22nd March 1976

*Laid before the House of
Commons* - - 30th March 1976

Coming into Operation - 20th April 1976

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Secretary of State, acting jointly, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 16(1) and (5) of the Agriculture (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1963(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, with the approval of the Treasury, hereby order as follows:—

Citation, extent and commencement

1. This order, which may be cited as the Diseases of Animals (Fees for the Testing of Disinfectants) Order 1976, shall apply to Great Britain and shall come into operation on 20th April 1976.

Interpretation

2.—(1) In this order “the Order of 1972” means the Diseases of Animals (Approved Disinfectants) Order 1972(b), as amended(c).

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(d) applies for the interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Fees for the testing of disinfectants

3. There shall be payable to the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food in respect of the testing, in pursuance of Article 5(1) of the Order of 1972, of any disinfectant submitted for the purpose of having such disinfectant listed as approved in the Schedule to that order the fees set out in the Schedule to this order.

Variation of the Diseases of Animals (Miscellaneous Fees) Order 1972

4. The Schedule to the Diseases of Animals (Miscellaneous Fees) Order 1972(e) shall be varied by omitting therefrom the entry in column 1 “7. Testing of any disinfectant submitted for listing as an approved disinfectant”, and the



entries in columns 2 and 3 opposite that entry specifying respectively the order relevant to, and the fees payable in respect of, the testing referred to in that entry.

SCHEDULE

FEES PAYABLE FOR THE TESTING OF DISINFECTANTS SUBMITTED FOR LISTING AS APPROVED
DISINFECTANTS

1. For each testing of a disinfectant for efficacy against Foot-and-Mouth Disease £65·00
2. For each testing of a disinfectant for efficacy against Fowl Pest—
 - (a) in the case of a single dilution test £65·00
 - (b) in the case of a multiple dilution test £90·00
3. For each testing of a disinfectant for efficacy against Tuberculosis..... £40·00
4. For each testing of a disinfectant for efficacy against Swine Vesicular Disease £85·00
5. For each testing of a disinfectant for efficacy against a disease of animals other than those mentioned in paragraphs 1 to 4 above..... £40·00
6. For each testing of a disinfectant for identity and stability..... £65·00
7. For administrative services in respect of each submission for testing of a disinfectant (whether for one, or for more than one, test)..... £30·00

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order prescribes the fees payable for the testing of disinfectants for the purpose of ascertaining whether they are fit to be listed as approved disinfectants in the Schedule to the Diseases of Animals (Approved Disinfectants) Order 1972, as amended. It also removes from the Diseases of Animals (Miscellaneous Fees) Order 1972 all references to such testing and to the fees payable therefor.
