The Legal Aid (Extension of Proceedings) Regulations 1976

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 7(2) and 20(1) of the Legal Aid Act 1974(a), hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Legal Aid (Extension of Proceedings) Regulations 1976 and shall come into operation on 30th March 1976.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply to these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. The proceedings in which legal aid may be given shall include proceedings in the Employment Appeal Tribunal.
