HIRE PURCHASE

The Control of Hiring (Amendment) Order 1976

Made - - - 5th April 1976

Laid before Parliament 6th April 1976

Coming into Operation 7th April 1976

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 1 and 7 of the Emergency Laws (Re-enactments and Repeals) Act 1964^(a) and all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Control of Hiring (Amendment) Order 1976 and shall come into operation on 7th April 1976.

2. The Control of Hiring Order 1973^(b) as varied ^(c) is hereby further varied in Part II of Schedule 1 by the insertion after item 8 of the following item:—

“9. Motor caravans, that is to say, vehicles primarily constructed or adapted to provide sleeping accommodation for not less than two persons and having permanently installed equipment for the cooking and consumption of food and for domestic washing.”
