**The Betting, Gaming and Lotteries Act 1963  
(Variation of Fees) Order 1976**

<i>Coming into Operation</i>	<i>31st May 1976</i>

In pursuance of sections 35(2) and 40(2) of, and Schedule 3 to, the Local Government Act 1966(a), I hereby make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Betting, Gaming and Lotteries Act 1963 (Variation of Fees) Order 1976 and shall come into operation on 31st May 1976.

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. The fee payable under paragraph 16 of Schedule 6 to the Betting, Gaming and Lotteries Act 1963(c) (which is set out in Part II of Schedule 11 to the Gaming Act 1968(d) and which relates to permits for the provision of amusements with prizes), as amended (e), shall (instead of £2) be £2.50.

4. In the Betting, Gaming and Lotteries Act 1963 (Variation of Fees) Order 1975(e), Article 3 shall be omitted.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Order.)*

This Order amends paragraph 16 of Schedule 6 to the Betting, Gaming and Lotteries Act 1963 so as to increase the fee payable to a local authority or other appropriate authority on the grant or renewal of a permit for amusements with prizes, from £2 to £2.50.
