

1976 No. 605 (L9)**COUNTY COURTS****The County Court Districts (Medway) Order 1976**

Made - - - - 13th April 1976

Coming into Operation 3rd May 1976

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the County Courts Act 1959(a), hereby makes the following Order:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the County Court Districts (Medway) Order 1976 and shall come into operation on 3rd May 1976.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. The Rochester County Court shall cease to be held at Rochester and shall hereafter be held at Chatham under the name of the Medway County Court; and accordingly Schedule 1 to the County Court Districts Order 1970(c) shall be amended:—

(a) by substituting “MEDWAY” for “ROCHESTER” in column 1; and

(b) by transferring the whole of the entry relating to “MEDWAY” to its proper alphabetical position therein.

3. No process shall be invalid only because the court is described therein as Rochester County Court.
