The Secretary of State for Education and Science, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Education Act 1962(a) as amended by section 2 of the Education Act 1975(b), and vested in him(c), hereby makes the following regulations:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the State Awards (European University Institute) Regulations 1976 and shall come into operation on 21st May 1976.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(d) shall apply for the interpretation of these regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Awards to students at the European University Institute

2. Regulation 3(1) (courses at which State Studentships are tenable) of the State Awards Regulations 1963(e) as amended(f) shall have effect with the addition at the end of the words “and full-time courses (in any subject) at the European University Institute in Florence”.
