Whereas it appears to me that the provisions of Part V of, and Schedule 8 to, the Licensing (Scotland) Act 1959(a) can have no further application:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the power conferred on me by section 5(1) and (2) of the Licensing (Abolition of State Management) Act 1971(b), I hereby make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Licensing (Scotland) Acts 1959 and 1962 (Repeal of State Management Provisions) (Scotland) Order 1976 and shall come into force on 1st June 1976 and the Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. The provisions of the Licensing (Scotland) Acts 1959 and 1962(d) specified in the Schedule to this Order are hereby repealed.
