**The Companies (Department of Trade) Fees (Amendment)
Order 1976**

Made - - - - - *3rd May 1976*
Coming into Operation *1st June 1976*

The Lord Chancellor and the Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 365(3) of the Companies Act 1948(a) and sections 2 and 3 of the Public Offices Fees Act 1879(b), hereby make, sanction and consent to the following Order:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Companies (Department of Trade) Fees (Amendment) Order 1976 and shall come into operation on 1st June 1976.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. The Companies (Department of Trade) Fees Order 1975(d) shall have effect subject to the following amendment:—

in Fee No. 6 in the Schedule to that Order, for the figure “£1·10” there shall be substituted the figure “£3·00”.
