**The Import Duties (Temporary Reductions and Exemptions)
(No. 10) Order 1976**

<i>Made - - - -</i>	19th May 1976
<i>Laid before the House of Commons</i>	20th May 1976
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	21st May 1976

The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury, by virtue of the powers conferred on them by sections 1, 3(6) and 13 of the Import Duties Act 1958(a), as amended by section 5(5) of, and paragraph 1 of Schedule 4 to, the European Communities Act 1972(b), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, on the recommendation of the Secretary of State(c), hereby make the following Order:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Import Duties (Temporary Reductions and Exemptions) (No. 10) Order 1976 and shall come into operation on 21st May 1976.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(d) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. In Article 2 of the Import Duties (Temporary Reductions and Exemptions) (No. 9) Order 1976(e) for “20th May 1976” there shall be substituted “31st May 1976”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order amends the Import Duties (Temporary Reductions and Exemptions) (No. 9) Order 1976 by continuing up to and including 31st May 1976 the exemption from import duty in the case of new potatoes.

These potatoes are subject to total suspension of duty in the Common Customs Tariff of the European Economic Community for the extended period in question and the exemption is made in accordance with the United Kingdom's Community obligations.
