Coming into Operation 1st July 1976

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 5(1) and (4) and 13 of, and paragraph 8 of Schedule 3 to, the Import Duties Act 1958(a), as amended by paragraph 1 of Schedule 4 to the European Communities Act 1972(b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Import Duties (Quota Relief) (No. 3) Order 1976 and shall come into operation on 1st July 1976.

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. The Import Duties (Quota Relief) (No. 4) Order 1975(d) shall be amended as follows:—

(a) in Article 3 the words “or, in the case of goods falling within sub-heading 48.01 E, 30th June 1976,” shall be deleted;

(b) in column 3 of Schedule 1 after “2886/75 (O.J. L292, 12.11.75, p. 30)” there shall be inserted “as amended by 1171/76 (O.J. L131, 20.5.76, p. 6.)”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order, which comes into operation on 1st July 1976, amends the Import Duties (Quota Relief) (No. 4) Order 1975 in relation to the tariff quota for certain newsprint. The Community Instrument specified in the 1975 Order by virtue of which the tariff quota was opened has been amended by a further Community Instrument, specified in this Order, which authorises until 31st December 1976 relief under the quota from import duty on unwatermarked or insufficiently watermarked newsprint of subheading 48.01 E.
