

**1976 No. 890 (L. 19)****COUNTY COURTS****The County Court Districts (Newton Abbot) Order 1976**

*Made* - - - - - *7th June 1976*

*Coming into Operation* *8th July 1976*

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the County Courts Act 1959(a), hereby makes the following Order:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the County Court Districts (Newton Abbot) Order 1976 and shall come into operation on 8th July 1976.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. The Newton Abbot County Court shall cease to be held at Newton Abbot and shall be held at Teignmouth; and accordingly Schedule 2 to the County Court Districts Order 1970(c), as amended (d), shall be further amended by adding in column 1 thereof, in the appropriate alphabetical position, “Newton Abbot” and, opposite thereto in column 2, “Teignmouth”.
