The Naval Detention Quarters (Amendment) Rules 1976

Made - - - - 8th June 1976

Laid before Parliament 16th June 1976

Coming into Operation 12th July 1976

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 82 of the Naval Discipline Act 1957(a), and by section 52 of the Courts-Martial (Appeals) Act 1968(b) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Rules:—

Citation and Commencement

1. These Rules may be cited as the Naval Detention Quarters (Amendment) Rules 1976, and shall come into operation on 12th July 1976.

Interpretation

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply to the interpretation of these Rules as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. In these Rules “the Principal Rules” means the Naval Detention Quarters Rules 1973(d), as amended(e).

Amendments to the Principal Rules

4.—(1) In Rule 12 of the Principal Rules for the words “once in each quarter” there shall be substituted the words “not less than once annually”.

(2) The following Rules of the Principal Rules shall be deleted—Rules 47(3)(b), 86(2)(b), 87(b) and 90.

(3) In Rule 51(2) of the Principal Rules the words “(other than a man undergoing restricted diet as a punishment)” shall be deleted.

(4) In Rule 89(3) of the Principal Rules the words “may be kept on restricted diet and” shall be deleted.

(5) In Rule 102(h) of the Principal Rules the words “or on restricted diet” shall be deleted.

These Rules amend the Naval Detention Quarters Rules 1973 to provide for the board of naval visitors to meet not less than once annually and to remove any provision for restricted diet to be awarded as a punishment.
