(University of Southampton) Order 1976**

Made - - - - - 9th June 1976

Coming into Operation 9th June 1976

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 9th day of June 1976

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Whereas by section 18(1) of the Medical Act 1969^(a) it is provided that if it appears to the General Medical Council that the standard of proficiency in medicine, surgery and midwifery required from candidates at examinations held or to be held by any university or combination of universities in the United Kingdom for the purpose of granting one or more primary qualifications is or will be such as is required in the case of a qualifying examination by section 10(1) of the Medical Act 1956^(b), the General Medical Council may represent to the Privy Council that it is expedient that those examinations should become qualifying examinations for the purposes of Part II of the Medical Act 1956:

And Whereas the General Medical Council have represented to the Privy Council that the University of Southampton holds such qualifying examinations requiring such a standard as aforesaid and that it is expedient that those examinations should become qualifying examinations for the purposes of Part II of the Medical Act 1956:

And Whereas by section 18(2) of the Medical Act 1969 it is provided that Her Majesty may by Order in Council give effect to any representation made to the Privy Council under section 18(1) of the said Act and that any such Order may make such amendments in section 11 of the Medical Act 1956 as are necessary for giving effect to the Order:

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred upon Her by section 18(2) of the Medical Act 1969 and of all other powers enabling Her in that behalf, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the General Medical Council (Qualifying Examinations) (University of Southampton) Order 1976.

2. The examinations in medicine, surgery and midwifery held by the University of Southampton for the purpose of granting one or more primary qualifications registrable under Part II of the Medical Act 1956 shall be qualifying examinations for the purposes of that Part of the said Act.

3. The Medical Act 1956 shall be amended by the insertion in section 11(1)(a) after the word "Nottingham", of the word "Southampton,".
