GUARANTEED PRICES AND ASSURED MARKETS

The Milk (Guaranteed Prices) (Amendment) Order 1976

Made - - - - - 21st January 1976

Laid before Parliament 3rd February 1976

Coming into Operation 1st April 1976

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, the Secretary of State for Scotland, the Secretary of State for Northern Ireland (being the Secretaries of State respectively concerned with agriculture in Scotland and Northern Ireland) and the Secretary of State for Wales, acting jointly, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by sections 1 and 35(3) of the Agriculture Act 1957(a), as read with the Transfer of Functions (Wales) Order 1969(b), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, with the consent of the Treasury and after consultation with such bodies of persons as appear to the said Ministers to represent the interests of producers of milk, hereby make the following order:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Milk (Guaranteed Prices) (Amendment) Order 1976 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1976.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply to the interpretation of this order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Amendment of principal order

2. The Milk (Guaranteed Prices) Order 1956(d) shall be amended by substituting therein for the word “gallon” wherever it appears the word “litre”, so however that in relation to any period before the commencement of this order the said order of 1956 shall continue to operate as if this order had not been made.

EXPLANATORY NOTE
