**The Common Agricultural Policy (Protection of Community Arrangements) (Amendment) Regulations 1977**

<i>Made</i>	- - -	27th July 1977
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>		5th August 1977
<i>Coming into Operation</i>		26th August 1977

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Secretary of State, being Ministers designated(a) in that behalf under section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972(b), in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by the said section 2(2) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following regulations:—

*Citation, commencement and interpretation*

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Common Agricultural Policy (Protection of Community Arrangements) (Amendment) Regulations 1977, and shall come into operation on 26th August 1977.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply to the interpretation of these regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

*Amendment*

2. The Common Agricultural Policy (Protection of Community Arrangements) Regulations 1973(d) as amended(e) are hereby further amended by inserting in the first column of the Schedule thereto immediately above the words "Milk Products" the word "Isoglucose".

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)*

These Regulations amend the Common Agricultural Policy (Protection of Community Arrangements) Regulations 1973 by extending the powers for the protection of the Community support system to cover the common regime for isoglucose set up by Council Regulation (EEC) No. 1111/77 of 17th May 1977 (O.J. No. L134, 28.5.77, p. 4).
