BOATS AND METHODS OF FISHING

The Herring (Specified Western Waters) (Prohibition of Fishing) (No. 2) Order 1977

Made - - - - 22nd December 1977

Laid before Parliament 30th December 1977

Coming into Operation 1st January 1978

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Secretaries of State respectively concerned with the sea fishing industry in Scotland and Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by sections 5(1) and (2) and 15 of the Sea Fish (Conservation) Act 1967(a) (as section 15 is amended by section 22(1) of, and paragraph 38 of Schedule 1 to, the Sea Fisheries Act 1968(b) and as sections 5(2) and 15 are amended by section 9(1) of, and paragraph 16(1) of Schedule 2 to, the Fishery Limits Act 1976(c)) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following order:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Herring (Specified Western Waters) (Prohibition of Fishing) (No. 2) Order 1977 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1978.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(d) shall apply to the interpretation of this order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Prohibition

2. Fishing for herring (*Clupea harengus*) within the area specified in the Schedule to this order is hereby prohibited.

3. In accordance with section 5(3) of the Sea Fish (Conservation) Act 1967, it is hereby declared that this order is not made for the sole purpose of giving effect to such a convention or agreement as is mentioned in section 5(1) of that Act.

Enforcement

4. For the purpose of the enforcement of this order, there are hereby conferred on every British sea-fishery officer the powers of a British sea-fishery officer under section 8(2) to (4) of the Sea Fisheries Act 1968 as subsection (4) is amended by section 9(1) of, and paragraph 17(1) of Schedule 2 to, the Fishery Limits Act 1976.

SCHEDULE

Article 2

AREA TO WHICH THE ORDER APPLIES

The area lying within British fishery limits bounded in the north by 52° 30' north latitude; in the east by 2° west longitude and the coasts of England and Wales; in the south by 48° north latitude; and in the west by 9° west longitude.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order prohibits fishing for herring in those parts of the Celtic Sea, the western English Channel and the Bristol Channel which lie inside British fishery limits.

By virtue of section 5(8) of the Sea Fish (Conservation) Act 1967, the Order applies to all fishing boats including foreign vessels.
