The Motor Vehicles (Tests) (Amendment) Regulations 1978

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of his powers under section 43(6) of the Road Traffic Act 1972(a) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with representative organisations in accordance with the provisions of section 199(2) of that Act, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Tests) (Amendment) Regulations 1978 and shall come into operation on 1st December 1978.
- 2. The Motor Vehicles (Tests) Regulations 1976(b), as amended (c), are hereby further amended by substituting, in column 2 of the Table in Part I of Schedule 5 (Fees for Examinations) thereto, "£2.70" for "£2.50" and "£4.50" for "£4.10".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Motor Vehicles (Tests) Regulations 1976 by increasing the fee for the examination of a motor bicycle (without sidecar) from £2.50 to £2.70 and the fee for the examination of any other motor vehicle to which the 1976 Regulations apply from £4.10 to £4.50.
