**The Goods Vehicles (Authorisation of International Journeys)
(Fees) (Amendment) Regulations 1978**

Made - - - 7th December 1978

Laid before Parliament 11th December 1978

Coming into Operation 1st January 1979

The Secretary of State for Transport, with the consent of the Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 56(1) and (2) of the Finance Act 1973(a), and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Goods Vehicles (Authorisation of International Journeys) (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations 1978 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1979.

2. The Goods Vehicles (Authorisation of International Journeys) (Fees) Regulations 1976(b), as amended(c), shall be amended in accordance with the following provisions of these Regulations.

3. In Regulation 2(1) (Interpretation) after the definition of “road-rail certificate” there shall be inserted the following definition:—

“‘special permit’ means a special permanent transport permit for the use in Spain of a vehicle exceeding a certain laden weight or dimensions, issued in pursuance of an arrangement made the 15th June 1978 between the Secretary of State for Transport in the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Minister of Transport of the Spanish State in implementation of the agreement dated 26th April 1972 between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the Spanish State on the International Carriage of Goods by Road(d);”.

4. In Regulation 6 (fee for road-rail certificate) after the words “road-rail certificate” there shall be inserted the words “or a special permit”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Goods Vehicles (Authorisation of International Journeys) (Fees) Regulations 1976, as amended, by introducing a fee of £2.50 for the issue on behalf of the Spanish Government of a special permanent transport permit for the use in Spain of a vehicle exceeding a certain laden weight or dimensions.
