## BETTING, GAMING AND LOTTERIES

## The Gaming Act (Variation of Fees) Order 1978

<i>Made - - - -</i>	<i>14th December 1978</i>
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	<i>29th December 1978</i>
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	<i>1st May 1979</i>

In pursuance of sections 48(5) and 51(4) of the Gaming Act 1968(a), I hereby make the following Order:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Gaming Act (Variation of Fees) Order 1978 and shall come into operation on 1st May 1979.

(2) This Order shall not extend to Scotland.

2.—(1) In this Order “the Act” means the Gaming Act 1968.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. The provisions of section 48(3) of the Act specified in the first column of the Schedule to this Order (which relate to fees charged in respect of the matters mentioned in the second column of that Schedule) shall have effect as if, for the references to the sums specified in those provisions (for which the sums mentioned in the third column of that Schedule were substituted by the Gaming Act (Variation of Fees) Order 1977(c)), there were substituted references to the sums specified in the fourth column thereof, respectively.

4. Section 48(4) of the Act (which relates to fees charged in respect of licences where gaming is limited to bingo) shall continue to have effect with the substitution for the references to the sums specified therein of references to the sums specified in the Gaming Act (Variation of Fees) Order 1977, except that for the references to the sums of £3,000, £600 and £450 there shall be substituted references to the sums of £8,700, £1,740 and £1,300 respectively.

5. In the Schedule to the Gaming Act (Variation of Fees) Order 1977 the following provisions shall be omitted:—

(a) the entries relating to paragraphs (a), (b), (c), (d) and (e) of section 48(3) of the Act;

(b) in the entry relating to paragraph (a) of section 48(4) of the Act, references to the sums of £2,000 and £3,000; and

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Order.)*

This Order increases the fees payable under the Gaming Act 1968 for the matters mentioned in the Schedule to the Order. Article 4 amends section 48(4) (which relates to fees payable for licences where gaming is limited to bingo) but does not increase those fees; the amendments are necessary because section 48(4) refers to fees increased by Article 3.
